



Corporate Member Award

Objective

This award recognizes one Corporate Member for outstanding contributions made to a local Chapter and the National Organization in the furtherance of the goals of the chapter and the society.

Award Criteria

To be nominated for this award a Corporation must have been an ASMC Corporate Member for at least two consecutive years immediately preceding award period. The Corporate Member's contribution must have applicability to the goals of the local chapter and the National organization. Notable contributions in fostering better understanding of private sector business environment and improvement in the relationship of DoD and private sector through education will be given more weight than just financial support. The performance period for the award is January 1 to December 31.

Submission Requirements

Each chapter may submit one nomination each year; submitted by the Chapter President, through the Awards Online system. The justification should address the following: Contributions of the Corporate Member, scope/impact of those contributions to the local ASMC chapter, and any unusual/innovative approaches and methods used to further promote the professional development of ASMC and its members.

Award Selection Procedures

A selection panel, chaired by the National Awards Committee and assisted by the Corporate Advisory Group Chairman, will review all nominations and make a final selection. Award will be presented at the annual ASMC Professional Development Institute (PDI). Chapters will be notified by May 1 if their nominee has been selected.

Recognition

Award will be presented at the National ASMC Professional Development Institute (PDI). Winning member may be featured in the *Armed Forces Comptroller* and the *National News*.

Deadline

All nominations must be received by April 10 to be considered by the selection panel. If April 10 falls on a weekend or holiday, the deadline will be the next business day. No exceptions to the deadline will be allowed.
